Horsemanship Agreement

I understand that horses are unpredictable animals and that even with all precautions, accidents still do occur.

I have read the following rules/warnings. If applicable I have read these to my child, _____ is also aware of these rules/warnings and agrees to abide by them:

1. Do not approach or handle horses unless an instructor or other barn personnel is present.
2. Do not stand directly in front of or behind a horse, the horse may kick you or run you over.
3. Do not stand close to a horse's hooves; the horse may step on your feet
4. Do not hand feed treats to horses. They may mistakenly bite you.
5. Do not wrap lead ropes or reins around your hands or other limbs. The horse may drag you.
6. Do not duck underneath the neck of a tied horse. You could be knocked down.
7. Do not run or scream around horses. They can become frightened and trample you or others in their effort to get away.
8. Do not mount your horse unless an instructor is present and has given you permission to do so.
9. When riding, have an instructor check your tack, especially your girth to make sure it is tight before mounting.
10. When riding, do not ride up close to another horse's hind quarters. Keep proper spacing between horses.
11. When riding, do not ask your horse to trot, canter, etc. unless told to do so by your instructor.
12. When riding, **always wear an approved ASTM-SEI Equestrian, long pants, and boots with a heel.**
